

Cleaning and care instructions



To keep your fursuit looking good for a long time, please follow these tips:

General information

- Always treat with cold water only.
- Avoid heat at all costs:
 - no warm/hot water
 - no dryer
 - no hot air
- If using a hairdryer, only use it on the coldest setting, from a great distance and keep it constantly moving.
- Brush thoroughly before and after wearing, as well as before and after each cleaning, to prevent matting.
- Always air out the fursuit sufficiently after wearing and washing.
- After a full wash, it can take several days for all items to dry completely – this is perfectly normal.
- Do not dry in direct sunlight, but choose a shady, well-ventilated place.
- Never store in a car, especially not in summer. Temperatures up to 60°C can:
 - Remove adhesive
 - Damage to plastic noses, 3D-printed eyes, or other parts

2. Cleaning – Head (Fursuit Head)

- Do not wash in a washing machine and never fully submerge in water (e.g., bathtub).
- The head is made of dense foam, from which large amounts of moisture cannot properly escape.
- Recommended cleaning methods:
 - Wipe inside and out with a damp cloth and mild fabric cleaner.
 - Optimal: Cleaning with a carpet cleaner and mild textile cleaner
 - only use cold water.
- Be sure to cover your eyes (e.g. with kitchen paper) to protect them from moisture.
- Brush thoroughly before and after cleaning to prevent matting.
- To dry, store the head upside down so that air can flow into the head through the neck.
- Ensure adequate air circulation and be patient – the drying process may take longer.

3. Cleaning – Small parts

(*Handpaws, Tail, Feetpaws*)

- Cleaning either:
 - in the washing machine or
 - by hand wash
- Washing machine:
 - gentle wash cycle
 - cold water
 - mild detergent
 - no fabric softener
 - Do not spin, as this can cause the filling to shift and the shape to change.
- A wet/dry vacuum cleaner is also well suited for light soiling.
- After cleaning:
 - Carefully wring out the water (do not twist).
 - Brush before and after washing
 - Hang in a well-ventilated place or let dry on a clothes rack.

4. Cleaning – Bodysuit

- Remove all stuffing before washing.
- Store the stuffing separately in two separate boxes/bags/cartons, so that the same amount can later be evenly distributed between both legs.
- Cleaning:
 - in the washing machine or
 - by handwashing in the bathtub
- Settings / Notes:
 - gentle wash cycle
 - cold water
 - mild detergent
 - no fabric softener
- For light soiling, a wet/dry vacuum cleaner can also be used here.
- After washing:
 - ventilate thoroughly
 - Allow to dry completely before reinserting the stuffing.

5. Storage

- **Store the fursuit in a well-ventilated place..**
- **Do not store permanently in cupboards or boxes (Exception: during transport or travel).**
- **Protect from direct sunlight to avoid material damage and fading.**
- **Before storage:**
 - **brush thoroughly**
 - **Allow to dry completely**
 - **Ventilate well**
- **Never store in the car (see General Instructions).**
